#### WISQARS (Web-based Injury Statistics Query and Reporting System)

Interactive database that lets you select demographic parameters and obtain reports and data for fatal and nonfatal injuries. Fatal injuries and estimates of medical and work loss costs for fatal injuries are available at the state level and maps are available showing fatality rates at the county level by an injury type for a state.

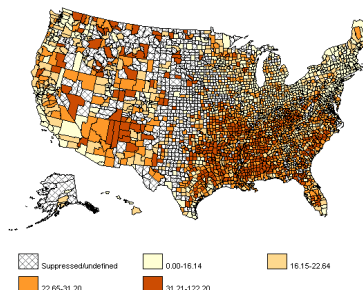
